

## **DIRECTIONS TO BARRY'S BAY FROM OTTAWA**

Takes approx. 2 hrs. from Toronto.

- Go west on Highway 417 and follow Highway 17 through Arnprior to Renfrew.
- At Renfrew, take the Bruce St. exit (the 3<sup>rd</sup> exit) until you reach the 3-way stop (at the Tim Horton's). Turn right (west) here.
- Follow Highway 60 into Douglas, where you will continue to follow Highway 60 by merging right.
- Follow Highway 60 to Kelly's Corners (the 4-way stop). Follow Highway 60 by turning left.
- You will now follow Highway 60 by traveling through Eganville, Golden Lake, Killaloe and Wilno.
- Barry's Bay is approximately 40 minutes west of Eganville.
- The Paul J. Yakabuski Arena is just as you come into town, signified by the rotating sign. It will be well marked.



## **DIRECTIONS TO BARRY'S BAY FROM TORONTO**

Takes approx. 3 ½ hrs. from Toronto.

- Go east on Highway 401 to the 35/115 cut-off (just past Bowmanville).
- Go North on Hwy 35/115 towards Peterborough.
- Continue on Hwy 115 to Peterborough, turn right (east) onto Hwy 7.
- At Hwy 28 turn left (north) to where it intersects with Hwy 28 (north) on the northside of Lakefield (approximately 16 kms).
- Go north on Hwy 28 to Bancroft (you will go through Young's Point, Burleigh Falls and Apsley). At Bancroft, take Hwy 62 North to Combermere (approximately 50km).
- At Combermere, continue on Hwy 62 for 15 kms.
- When you reach Barry's Bay, turn right at the 3-way stop. The Paul J. Yakabuski Community Centre is approximately 1.5 kms east of the intersection. It is signified by the rotating sign.
